“Founder of Iran Zamin is Cyrus the Great” Part One/Childhood

Cyrus the Great is founder of Iran Zamin and was born in 580 BC. 1 There is a mystery about his birth and early childhood, and Herodotus Greek Historian says that “Cyrus’ early life belongs to a genre of legends in which abandoned children of [noble birth](#),² such as [Oedipus](#) 3 and [Romulus and Remus](#),⁴ return to claim their royal positions. His overlord was his own grandfather, [Astyages](#), 5 ruler of the powerful Median kingdom.”⁶ One night, after birth of Cyrus, Astyages had a dream and his Magi interpreted as a sign that his grandson would overthrow him. 7 Astyages ordered his steward [Harpagus](#) 8 to kill the infant Cyrus. 9 Harpagus took the infant and could not kill the baby Cyrus, and “summoned a herdsman of the king named [Mithridates](#) 10 and ordered him to dispose of the child.

Luckily for the young boy, the herdsman took him in and raised him as his own.” 11

When Cyrus was ten years old Astyages observed Cyrus, and Astyages interviewed Cyrus and came to conclusion that Cyrus was not a herdsman, but he was coming from noble family. 12 Plus, there was a physical resemblance between Cyrus and Astyages. 13 Therefore, Astyages summoned [Harpagus](#) 14 and made inquiry about inquiry about that faithful night. 15 [Harpagus](#) explained to Astyages that he did not kill the baby Cyrus and left him with the herdsman. 16 Astyages did not like the idea that [Harpagus](#) disobeyed his direct order. 17 Astyages killed [Harpagus](#)'s son and tricked [Harpagus](#) to eat his son, 18 a pain which was going to linger on [Harpagus](#) for a very long time. Astyages did not order anyone to execute the Cyrus, and allowed him to rejoin to his family. Cyrus father was a Persian King Cambyses and his mother Mandane was daughter of Astyages who was a Mede King.

The above history was narrated by a Greek historian with name of Herodotus. It appears that the above version of Cyrus the Great's early childhood maybe flaw and have not merit because since Cyrus the Great's father, Cambyses, was King of Persia and Cyrus was Heir to Throne of Persia, Cambyses would not allow Astyages to kidnap His son with intention of murdering Him. In 1979 there was a riot in Iran under banner of Islamist-Marxist and changed lives of people in Iran dramatically. Where killers called political dissidents and good people were called as killers. Ebrahim Yazdi had no knowledge of legal system and formed "Kangaroo" court and lined up Imperial Iranian Armed Forces from high ranking officer to a foot soldier and he was acting as a judge, jury, and executioner.
