Organize of Imperial Iranian Armed Forces {Infantry}

- 1. One squad is composed of nine soldiers, a First or Second Sergeant as a commander.
- 2. Three squads plus one squad of *Adovat* which would become thirty persons. One squad of *Adovat* is composed of twelve persons that they carry two mortars and two heavy machine guns. In this case, they carry two mortars of 60 milliliter barrel. Military rank would be a First Sergeant as a commander of one squad and one officer with rank of First or Second Lieutenant would be the commander of these three squads which has formed a platoon.
- 3. Three platoons and one Capitan as a deputy commander, and a First Lieutenant as a commander. This would be one company.
- 4. Three companies plus one company of *Adovat*. One Major as a commander. This would be one troop.
- 5. Three troops and one troop of *Adovat* gives one regiment. One Third-Colonel as a commander and Second Colonel as a deputy commander.
- 6. Three regiments is one brigade. It is commanded by a Brigade-General and one Colonel as a deputy of brigade.
- 7. Three brigades is one battalion, and is commanded by a Major-General.
- 8. Three battalions is one Corps, and is commanded by one Lieutenant-General.
- 9. Three Corps is one infantry army and is commanded by one General.
- 10. Commander in Chief was His Imperial Majesty, Light of Aryan, King of Kings Mohammad Reza Pahlavi.
